Stewards today 7th August 2013 finalised an investigation into the eligibility of the greyhound TOKEN SPINNER which competed in and won the Emerley Park Maiden Stakes at the Virginia meeting on the 19th May 2013

It was established that due to all coursing meeting fields having to be manually compiled, the greyhound TOKEN SPINNER had been inadvertently placed in the field when under an interstate suspension.

Mrs.Eva Sheriff trainer of TOKEN SPINNER had attempted to clarify the eligibility with an interstate authority prior to nominating and after receiving a start was of the opinion that the greyhound was cleared to compete.

Taking this into account she was advised that due to the mitigating circumstances involved in this case no further action would be taken against her.

Stewards acting under the rules of Greyhound Racing disqualified TOKEN SPINNER as the winner of the event and amended the placing's accordingly.
