## ***NOTIFICATION OF POSITIVE SAMPLE***

On Thursday 5 July, 2018, Trainer Mr. Jamie Quinlivan was informed that the urine sample taken from the greyhound MR. WORLDWIDE had shown the presence of CAFFEINE and its metabolites THEOPHYLLINE, PARAXANTHINE and THEOBROMINE at the Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) race meeting held at Angle Park on Monday 21 May, 2018.

The reserve portion of the urine sample was tested and the presence of CAFFEINE and its metabolites THEOPHYLLINE, PARAXANTHINE and THEOBROMINE were confirmed

Mr. Quinlivan is now required to be available for a Stewards inquiry, together with any witnesses that may assist, into the circumstances relating to the obtaining of the positive urine sample. This will be at a date to be fixed.

As a result of this inquiry, charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.

He was further advised that if he does not attend this inquiry it may be held in his absence and charges may be laid pursuant to GRSA Rules of Greyhound Racing.
