NOTICE OF INQUIRY RESULT

STEWARDS: L.G. Michalanney, D. Jonas, M. Fernholz

On Monday 8 October, 2018, Greyhound Racing South Australia (GRSA) Stewards inquired into the analysis of a post-race urine sample taken from the greyhound MR. WORLDWIDE trained by Mr. Jamie Quinlivian at the race meeting held at Angle Park on Monday 21 May, 2018.

The prohibited substances CAFFEINE and its metabolites THEOPHYLLINE, PARAXANTHINE and THEOBROMINE were confirmed in the analysis of the sample.

Evidence was taken from Mr. Paul Zahra (Racing Analytical Services Limited), Dr. Steven Karamatic (Veterinarian) and Mr. Quinlivian.

After considering the matter and all evidence before them, Stewards believed there was sufficient evidence to issue a charge against Mr. Quinlivian under GAR 83(2), which reads:

The owner, trainer or person in charge of a greyhound – (a) nominated to compete in an event; shall present the greyhound free from any prohibited substance

Mr. Quinlivian pleaded guilty to the charge.

Mr. Quinlivian was disqualified for a period of four (4) months. The disqualification period will commence at midnight on Wednesday 17 October, 2018.

In assessing penalty Stewards took into consideration his plea of guilt, his time and involvement in the industry, and his cooperation during the inquiry process. However, Stewards remain mindful there should be specific and general deterrence to ensure the onus is on Trainers to present their greyhounds free from any prohibited substances.

Furthermore, Stewards acting under GAR 83(4) disqualified MR. WORLDWIDE from Race 8 at Angle Park on Monday 21 May, 2018.

Mr. Quinlivian was advised of his rights of appeal.
