Stewards' Notice

IHP Determination - allegations of ill-treatment of greyhounds

Greyhound Racing SA Limited (GRSA) today closed the Inquiry in relation to allegations of illtreatment of greyhounds on the property of former registered persons Mrs Lisa and Mr Tony Rasmussen.

Both Mrs and Mr Rasmussen were suspended from the sport, pursuant to R169(5), *Greyhounds Australasia Rules*, from 26th July 2023 when GRSA opened the Inquiry arising from footage aired in the public domain, on 25th July 2023, of Mr Rasmussen assaulting a number of greyhounds at his property in regional South Australia. For one part of the footage, and for one greyhound, Mrs Rasmussen was present at the scene. The property subject to the conduct was de-registered as an approved property to keep or train greyhounds. Stewards later charged Mrs and Mr Rasmussen with various breaches of the *Greyhounds Australasia Rules* (GAR) and *Local Rules* (LR) and referred the Inquiry to GRSA's Integrity Hearings Panel (**IHP**). On Friday 7th June 2024, the IHP further heard the Inquiry.

Registered persons who are disqualified are not permitted to own or train any registered greyhound for the period of the disqualification, and they also have their registration automatically cancelled. Further, other registered persons are not permitted to associate with a disqualified person, for any purpose connected with greyhound racing. This applies to all states in Australia as well as New Zealand. Further, no registered person is permitted to keep any of their own greyhounds at any premises of a disqualified person in South Australia.
