Stewards' Notice

Allegations of live baiting

Inquiry update (determination) (rule 13(1)(f) Greyhounds Australasia Rules ("GAR"))

On Friday 16th June 2023, Greyhound Racing SA Integrity Hearings Panel ("**IHP**") heard and determined an Inquiry commenced on 24th August 2022, relating to alleged live baiting by a number of registered persons (all suspended from holding registration from 24th August 2022). The IHP heard charges laid by Stewards, and made the following orders for those charges –

Mr Troy Murray

- 1. Use animal in connection with greyhound training or racing (rule 159(1)(a) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- Bring live animal (other than a greyhound) onto a property (rule 162(b) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- Possess a lure containing animal material (rule 159(5)(b) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- 4. Conduct detrimental to racing (rule 165(a) GAR) **life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine.**

Mr Jackson Murray

- 1. Use animal in connection with greyhound training or racing (rule 159(1)(a) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- 2. Conduct detrimental to racing (rule 165(a) GAR) **life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine**.

Mr Connor Murray

- 1. Being indirectly involved or knowingly concerned with live baiting (rule 159(1)(f) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- Impede officer of the Controlling Body (rule 156(g)(ii) GAR) life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine;
- 3. Conduct detrimental to racing (rule 165(a) GAR) **life disqualification and \$20,000.00 fine.**

The fines with respect to each registered person are cumulative.

The property associated with the offending was de-registered by the Controlling Body as an approved greyhound property on 29th August 2022.
