Stewards' Notice

Allegations of live baiting

Inquiry update (rule 13(1)(f) Greyhounds Australasia Rules)

Greyhound Racing SA Stewards, in relation to the Inquiry commenced on 24th August 2022, relating to two people allegedly involved in live baiting, together with a third person associated with the investigation today laid the following charges, pursuant to the Greyhounds Australasia Rules (GAR) –

Person A

- Use animal in connection with greyhound training, rule 159(1)(a) GAR;
- Bring live animal (other than greyhound) onto property, rule 162(b) GAR;
- Possess a thing containing animal material, rule 159(5)(b) GAR
- Conduct detrimental to racing, rule 165(a) GAR

Person B

- Use animal in connection with greyhound training, rule 159(1)(a) GAR;
- Conduct detrimental to racing, rule 165(a) GAR;

Person C

- Being indirectly involved or knowingly concerned with live baiting, rule 159(1)(f) GAR;
- Impede officer of the Controlling Body, rule 156(g) GAR;
- Conduct detrimental to racing, rule 165(a) GAR

The Inquiry has been adjourned to a date to be fixed, for Stewards to continue investigations, hear and determine the charges.

Due to an associated criminal investigation by the RSPCA South Australia, Greyhound Racing SA will not comment further, so as to not prejudice the RSPCA investigation.

Suspensions for the three registered persons, in place since the start of the Inquiry on 24th August 2022, remain in effect.
