Turning into the home straight CHARLIE CHOPS moved out checking LONG GULLY ELLA and BIG BUZZ causing BIG BUZZ to be turned sideways and stumble

-BIG BUZZ was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 7 DAYS

-MAGIC CONDE was slow to begin. On the first turn MIDNIGHT MCQUEEN ran onto the heels of and dragged down ROSCOMMON FLYER. Turning off the back straight MAGIC CONDE eased appearing injured. Turning into the home straight BIG BLACK SIYAN moved out taking DOLLY JO wide. Along the home straight DAISY MAREE checked around the heels of BESIDE MYSELF.  
 -MAGIC CONDE was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 7 DAYS.  
 -ROSCCOMMON FLYER was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.
