-A swab sample was taken from the winner ALLINGA JESS.  
-IROQUOIS LADY was slow to begin. Approaching the first turn IROQUOIS LADY moved down checking NAUGHTON and DOROTHY LEE resulting in NAUGHTON being dragged down. NAUGHTON ran wide entering the home straight.  
-DOROTHY LEE was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.  
-NAUGHTON was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 7 DAYS.

-EMERLEY COSMIC was very slow to begin. On the first turn ASHOM MONELLI lost a little ground when tightened by DAISY MAREE.

-SHORTLY AFTER THE START PORT SIDE stumbled and eased. On the first turn MY NAME'S HALEY and MAX POTION bumped as MAX POTION moved down. Approaching the turn into the straight MAX POTION made contact with the running rail.  
-PORT SIDE was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 3 MONTHS.  
-MAX POTION was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.
