Race 1	THE BUNYIP MAIDEN STAKE	1.44pm	400m	Maiden

-A swab sample was taken from the winner MORE VALUE.
-COURTNEY LEE was slow to begin. Entering the back straight VICTA SCOBY moved out checking ABBEY'S LEGACY. Approaching the turn into the home straight EMERLEY EXPRESS moved out making contact with WOODSIDE PUMA causing EMERLEY EXPRESS to lose ground.
-Stewards questioned Mr. V. Roz, representing trainer Ms. J. Hurley regarding the racing manners of EMERLEY EXPRESS approaching the turn into the home straight. Mr. Roz was advised the future performance of the greyhound would be monitored.

-WOODSIDE SABRE was slow to begin. On the first turn THAT IF moved out checking SWIPE UP and GREEN BLACK SASH, then shortly after THAT IF ran onto the heels of TULLABUNG MISSY.

-Entering the back straight GOT MY WAY moved out checking ASTON MAMBO and NIGEL LEE. On the turn off the back straight HE'S AUGUSTA LAD moved down checking VICTA CHARLIE.
-VICTA CHARLIE was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.

-On the first turn ZIZOU DE KAHN checked around the heels of MOTOWN KENNY. There were no further racing incidents to report.

-On the first turn FLY BY THEM moved down checking VALIDE. Approaching the turn into the back straight ALLINGA MAL moved out checking ATOMIC BLONDE and STITCH 'EM MILLI. Approaching the turn into the home straight MAGIC HAT moved down onto ATOMIC BLONDE causing ATOMIC BLONDE to make contact with the running rail.
-ATOMIC BLONDE was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.

-A swab sample was taken from the winner STITCH 'EM CILLA.
-On the turn off the back straight FEELIN' moved out checking ALLINGA JESS then shortly after checked around the heels of HOT ZORRO.
-Approaching the turn into the home straight FEELIN' turned its head outwards at HOT ZORRO, then shortly after moved out checking HOT ZORRO and was reported for failing to pursue. FEELIN' was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED. Stewards acting under GAR69A(2)(a) SUSPENDED FEELIN' FOR 28 DAYS GAWLER ONLY AND UNTIL THE COMPLETION OF A SATISFACTORY TRIAL.

-A swab sample was taken from the winner ASTON NIRVANA.
-GREYSYND MERCURY was slow to begin. On the first turn GREYSYND MERCURY ran onto the heels of and dragged down WATSARGO. On the turn into the back straight ZARBO HUSTLER checked around the heels of GREYSYND MERCURY.
-WATSARGO was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 28 DAYS.

-Shortly after the start ASTON NARITA moved down checking PLAY THAT SONG. On the turn off the back straight SILVER TIMOTHY moved out checking ASTON NARITA then ASTON NARITA dropped back checking DONNA PAULSEN. Approaching the turn into the home straight MINNIE MAC checked around the heels of MUCHACHOS.
-ASTON NARITA was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 14 DAYS.

-On the first turn CRACKENBACK moved down checking RORY KADE, ROSCOMMON FLYER and CRAZY AGAIN, then shortly after RORY KADE checked around the heels of STEEL and moved out checking LONG GULLY ELLA. On the turn off the back straight ROSCOMMON FLYER moved out checking RORY KADE.

-A swab sample was taken from the winner EMERLEY ZERO.

-There were no racing incidents to report.

-Entering the back straight VICTA CHOCO moved out checking DREAM BREAKER. Approaching the turn into the home straight VICTA CHOCO moved out bumping with SUTTON HEIDI.

As a result, GREYSYND MERCURY underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Stewards questioned trainer and handler Mr. K. Murnane about the events leading to GREYSYND MERCURY becoming loose. Mr Murnane explained that he believed the collar was unusually smooth underneath and this combined with the greyhound's behaviour is the reason why it became loose. Mr. Murnane informed Stewards that he would not use this collar with this greyhound in the future. Stewards noted Mr. Murnane's explanation.
