STEWARDS NOTES	During the lure preview for Race 7 FANTASTIC BRONX became loose, and ran from near the winning post to the 731m boxes and grabbed the lure. As a result, FANTASTIC BRONX underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was then taken out by the order of Stewards. Stewards questioned Trainer Mr. Richard Stasiak about the events leading to FANTASTIC BRONX becoming loose. Mr. Stasiak explained that excitability contributed to the greyhound slipping its collar during the preview. Stewards noted Mr Stasiak's explanation and issued a fine of \$100 under GAR 86(o), as Stewards were of the opinion that Mr. Stasiak acted negligently by not ensuring he had full control of the greyhound.
