Race 1 G-SIX JINGLE BELLS STAKE

515m Grade 5

- -A swab sample was taken from the winner LUCY'S NIMBUS.
- -On the first turn VIKING VINCE moved down checking HELLO I'M JADE. There were no further racing incidents to report.

Race 2 G-SIX KRIS KRINGLE JUVENILE STAKE

388m Juvenile

-On the first turn CONNER PERUZZI moved down checking EMERLEY SKIMMER then continued to move down bumping GOLDEN CREST causing CONNER PERUZZI to lose ground.

Race 3 G-SIX SILENT NIGHT STAKE

88m Grade 6

- -On the first turn PUMA COUNTRY ran onto the heels of and dragged down LEFEVRE LILL, shortly after MY LIL LOUIE moved down checking GRONK.
- -LEFEVRE LILL was vetted after the race with NO INJURY DETECTED.

Race 4 G-SIX SEASON'S GREETINGS MIXED STAKE

388m Mixed 4/5

-Along the back straight CLASSY BLAZE moved down checking SLIPPERY JACK. Approaching the turn into the home straight CLASSY BLAZE and SLIPPERY JACK came together causing both greyhounds to lose ground, shortly after ZIPPING CAESAR moved out taking EXCITING TIMES wide.

Race 5 LITTLE DRUMMER BOY OPEN STAKE

388m Open

-On the first turn MAGIC BEGINS moved down checking RESOLUTE LEE. There were no further racing incidents to report.

Race 6 FESTIVE SEASON STAKE

515m Grade 6

-Shortly after the start GEMTREE ABLAZE moved out as CALLANISH SPRITE moved down, checking CAWBOURNE SNOW, SPRINGVALE ISSY and CASTLE RUINS. On the first turn GEMTREE ABLAZE moved out checking CALLANISH SPRITE then OOPS A DAISY moved down checking GEMTREE ABLAZE, shortly after CASTLE RUINS moved down checking SPRINGVALE ISSY then CAWBOURNE SNOW moved out checking OOPS A DAISY. Approaching the turn into the home straight CASTLE RUINS moved down checking GEMTREE ABLAZE.

Race 7 HOLY NIGHT GRADE 6 SERIES FINAL

515m Grade 6

-BIG BURNER went up with the lids. On the first turn JABARI moved out checking BUDDY GUY, FINNISS LOOPER and LONG GULLY BARNY, shortly after LONG GULLY BARNY moved down checking FINNISS LOOPER then ARTISTIC LEE ran onto the heels of BUDDY GUY causing ARTISTIC LEE to move out, forcing BIG BURNER to race wide. On the turn into the back straight BUDDY GUY checked around the heels of LONG GULLY BARNY. On the turn off the back straight BIG BURNER moved down checking PETER THIEF.

Race 8 RUDOLPH THE RED-NOSE REINDEER MIXED STAKE

515m Mixed 3/4/5

- -On the first turn TWO TIMES TWICE checked around the heels of GEMTREE DYNAMO then continued out checking CHADDY WHACKER and CONNOR ALLEN.
- -TWO TIMES TWICE was vetted after the race, REPORTED TO BE INJURED AND WAS STOOD DOWN FOR 7 DAYS.

Race 9 G-SIX SANTA CLAUSE IS COMING TO TOWN MIXED STAKE

600m Mixed 4/5

-On the first turn MASTER CHAOS moved out bumping MISS TAKIRI and COCO SPECTRE. There were no further racing incidents to report.
-Stewards questioned Trainer Mr P Rehmann, representing Trainer Mrs I Rehmann, with regards to the racing manners of MASTER CHAOS along the home straight. Stewards were not satisfied there was sufficient evidence to proceed with charges. Mr Rehmann was advised the greyhound's performance would be monitored during future events.

Race 10 YULETIDE FREE FOR ALL

731m FFA

-AMARA LUCY went up with the lids and SIR TRUCULENT jumped with the field but was slow to muster early pace. There were no further racing incidents to report.

Race 11 G-SIX CHRISTMAS CAROLS STAKE

388m Grade 6

-On the first turn SWEET LEE moved down checking ZOLTAN causing ZOLTAN to move out checking MISSY TWO TOES, EMERLEY DRUMMER and BELLA PERUZZI.

Race 12 G-SIX MERRY CHRISTMAS FROM GRSA (N/P) STAKE

388m Masters

- -On the first turn VELOCITY FLAME moved down checking WATTO'S REVENGE, MILES PER GALLON and MR. DAGWOOD. On the turn off the back straight SLIPPER'S SODA moved down checking WATTO'S REVENGE and MR. DAGWOOD. On the turn into the home straight SLIPPER'S SODA and SUTTON HEIDI bumped.
- -Stewards questioned Trainer Mr B Jones with regards to the racing manners of SLIPPER'S SODA on the turn into the home straight shortly before receiving interference. Stewards were not satisfied there was sufficient evidence to proceed with charges. Mr Jones was advised the greyhound's performance would be monitored during future events.
